### **DUTIES:** (Summary Only)

Provides habilitative services to children ages birth through three with developmental delays and/or disabilities, or who are at significant developmental risks, due to conductive or sensorineural hearing loss and their families; services include assessment of communication function, home based and center based therapy process (i.e. auditory training, communication training or speech-language training, sign language) instruction for interested families and/or appropriate referrals to outside sources; parental empowerment, education and advocacy. Provides indirect, direct and consultative services. Assists families in obtaining hearing screenings and tests to determine accurate hearing levels of infants and toddlers; accesses audiological services as needed; interprets test results from outside sources; coordinates other assessments to determine current levels of development in all areas; accesses appropriate team members to perform further assessment as needed; informs parents of impact of hearing loss on development; presents families with possible communication methodologies in an objective, non-biased manner; assists families in identifying needs and goals as they pertain to their infant/toddler. Assists in all aspects of activities as outlined in the project application including but not limited to speaking to COGs in the 9 county region; developing a brochure on project purpose and activities; contacting a variety of service providers including medical facilities and personnel; writing and submitting articles to the local papers; coordinate and conduct two public hearing screenings throughout the year; provide training to other staff members.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

Bachelor's Degree in social work, education, nursing or related field. 1 year's experience working with individuals with developmental disabilities preferred. Possession of or ability to obtain Ohio Department of Education Early Childhood Intervention Specialist License; Ohio Department Education Early Childhood license; Ohio Department of DD Early Intervention Certificate; Ohio Department of Education Certified Audiologist; Licensed Audiologist as required under Ohio Revised Code; Ohio Department of Education Certified Speech Language Pathologist; Licensed Speech Language Pathologist as required under Ohio Revised Code; or parent of a hard of hearing/deaf child holding a four-year degree from Accredited University in social work, education, and nursing or related field and eligible for certification. Must maintain certification. May be required to lift, carry, and move children in a safe manner. Successfully pass pre-employment BCII check, Abuser Registry check, and Nursing Registry check.
